OUTPATIENT AND SPECIALTY CLINICS

Only one (1) essential caregiver may accompany a member/patient.

This may include:

- a support person for a minor (under 18 years)
- a support person for persons with cognitive or physical disabilities who require assistance
- language assistance if interpretive services are not sufficient
- clinical exceptions may apply for OB-GYN procedures
